I refer to your application pursuant to the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act) received by the Department of Environment and Water (DEW) on 1 November 2021 and transferred to Dog and Cat Management Board seeking access to:

*“Through the Dog and Cat Management Board. Dog breeding history of DACO # 117382 from July 2020 up to when this application is processed (approximately 1st December 2021). Breeding history documents of the above DACO # and possibly named under breeder Stacey Judd and 'Glamorous Goldens'. Please search documents for the above three as breeding is under these three trading names.
Timeline: between 1/07/2020 to 1/11/2021*

In response to being informed of the type of data held in DACO, on 18 February 2022, the scope of the request was reduced to:

“The number of microchips associated with either the DACO breeding number 117382, the breeder Stacey Judd or 'Glamorous Goldens', from 1 July 2020 to 17 February 2022.

Section 19(2a) of the FOI Act, provides that an agency may give access to a document on an application after the period within which it was required to deal with the application (and any such determination is to be taken to have been made under this Act).

FOI FACT SHEET

Your Rights to Review and Appeal

South Australian Freedom of Information Act 1991

EXTERNAL REVIEW

If you are unhappy with the determination, you have the right to apply for an External Review. All applications for External Review should be made to the Ombudsman SA.

How long will an External Review take and how much will it cost?

If you wish to make an application for an External Review you must do so within 30 calendar days after being notified of the determination. However, the Ombudsman SA can extend this time limit at their discretion. There is no fee or charge for External Reviews undertaken by the Ombudsman.

REVIEW BY SACAT
